





Virginia Forestry Summit - April 28-May 1, 2020

Dear Forestry Supporter:

The 2020 Virginia Forestry Summit will be held April 28-May 1, at the Hotel Madison in Harrisonburg, Virginia. This year's theme is:

20/20: Seeing the Forests through the Trees

This event brings together a coalition of forest landowners, forest products business owners, industry and natural resource professionals, and others from Virginia Forestry Association (VFA), the Virginia Chapter of the Association of Consulting Foresters (ACF), and the Virginia Division of the Society of American Foresters (SAF).

Your support is needed to make this meeting a success!

More than 1,400 forest landowners, loggers, foresters, forest products companies, businesses and citizens of Virginia who are members of these organizations are invited to attend the Summit. Your participation offers the opportunity to meet and interact with this diverse group of individuals from the forestry community.

The Summit will feature an offsite Welcome Dinner for attendees on Tuesday, April 28, educational speakers and sessions on Wednesday, April 29, and Thursday, April 30, and workshops and tours Thursday and Friday, May 1. Keynote speakers include Bruce Vincent, a third generation Montana logger with a unique perspective on forestry and the community's pathway for the future; Heidi Brock, President & CEO of American Forest & Paper Association; and Dr, Bob Holsworth, Virginia's own political visionary. This year's general and concurrent sessions will also focus on hardwood markets and trade, Virginia's hardwood initiative, transportation safety, business communication tools, forest health, urban wood markets, and hazards in the woods. There will be celebratory receptions, offsite tours, and workshops sprinkled throughout the week and a reception and awards banquet Thursday evening. SPONSOR

All sponsor levels include the sponsor's logo in the event program and on VFA's website, and sponsor's name on banner displays in the exhibit hall and on monitor displays in the meeting rooms. Walnut and Cherry level sponsors will have additional benefits, as described below.
